Presenting the BSB963 “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” Project

George Zaimes presented with a poster the project at MONITOX International Conference “Environmental Toxicants in Freshwater and Marine Ecosystems in the Black Sea Basin”, Kavala, GREECE, September 8th-11th, 2020. The conference was held in person and online with ZOOM.
