Presenting results of BSB963 “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” Project

George Zaimes and Valasia Iakovoglou from IHU-SARF presented results at the WaSec Dissemination Workshop on January 13th 2022 in Amman, Jordan. The purpose of the workshop to showcase innovative projects on climate change and water management by experts from different institutions.

The Dissemination workshop was organized by the University of Jordan for the ERASMUS + project Innovations in Water Education: Enhancing Water Security and Socio-economic Development in the Eastern Mediterranean under Climate Change (WaSec).
