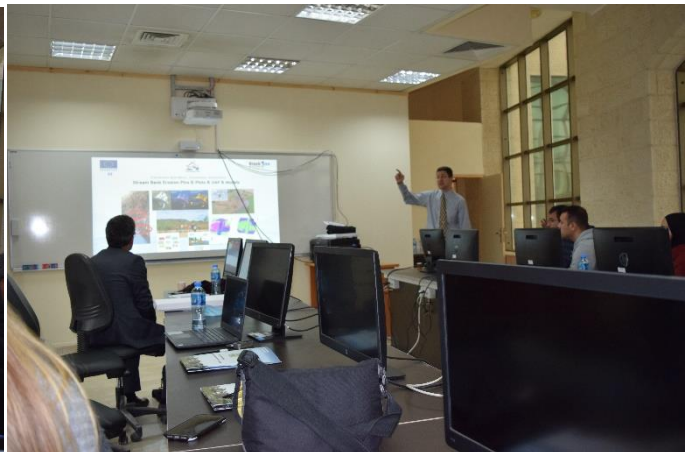

### Presenting results of BSB963 “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” Project

George Zaimes and Valasia Iakovoglou from IHU-SARF presented results at the WaSec Tester Workshop on March 13<sup>th</sup> 2022 in Tulkarm, Palestine. The purpose of the workshop to showcase innovative projects on climate change and water management to graduate students of universities of the region.

The Tester workshop was organized by the Palestinian Technical University of Kadoorie for the ERASMUS + project Innovations in Water Education: Enhancing Water Security and Socio-economic Development in the Eastern Mediterranean under Climate Change (WaSec). In the workshop more than 30 people attended it.

The oral presentation showcased briefly the results of the “Protecting streams for a clean Black Sea by reducing sediment and litter pollution with joint innovative monitoring and control tools and nature-based practices.”
