Presenting the Methodology to be used in the BSB963 Protect-Streams-4-Sea” Project

George Zaimes, the Project Coordinator of the “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” project was an invited to present the project at the MONITOX International Conference “Environmental Challenges in the Black Sea Basin: Impact on Human Health”, Galati, Romania, September 23rd-26th, 2020. The conference was held in person and online with Microsoft Teams.

The title of the presentation was “The use of GIS to determine stream bank erosion prone areas in two watersheds of Greece.” The authors were Georgios Pagonis, Valasia Iakovoglou, George N. Zaimes. The methodology described in this paper will be also utilized and in the “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” project.

The conference was held for the project BSB27-MONITOX “Black Sea Basin interdisciplinary cooperation network for sustainable joint monitoring of environmental toxicants migration, improved evaluation of ecological state and human health impact of harmful substances, and public exposure prevention” and organized by Dunarea de Jos University of Galati (UDJG), Romania that is the lead partner.
