Presenting an overview of BSB963 “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” Project

George Zaimes, the Project Coordinator of the “Protect-Streams-4-Sea” project presented an overview at the Med 2020 International Conference “THE MEDITERRANEAN: SCIENTIFIC EXPERTISE FOR DECISION-MAKERS - Climate and environmental research to support sustainable development goals” (<https://med2020.sciencesconf.org/>), November 16th-18th, 2020 that was held online.

The poster presentation provided a brief overview of the “Protecting streams for a clean Black Sea by reducing sediment and litter pollution with joint innovative monitoring and control tools and nature-based practices” to decision makers around the Mediterranean. The authors were George N. Zaimes, Valasia Iakovoglou and Dimitrios Emmanouloudis.
