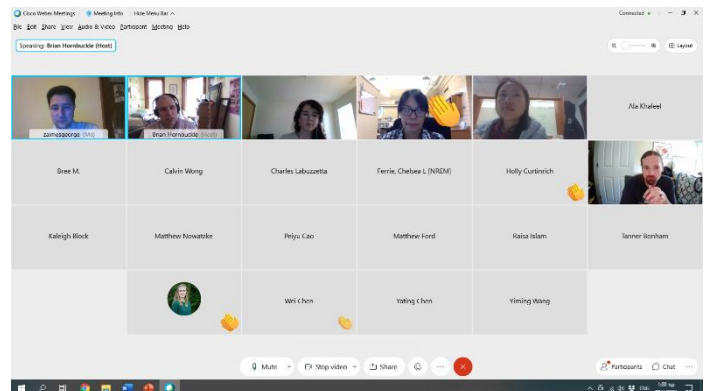
Twenty students participated in the seminar that showed great interest in the project.
