The International Hellenic University Special Account for Research Funds (IHU-SARF), in collaboration with institutions from Turkey (Artvin Coruh University), Moldova (Eco-TIRAS International Association of River Keepers), Armenia (Young Foresters Union NGO, ARMENIA) and Romania (Buzău-Ialomița Water Administration), as the Lead Beneficiary (The International Hellenic University), within the EU INTERREG IV program "Black Sea Basin Joint Operational Program 2014-2020" the project entitled: " **Protecting streams for a clean Black Sea by reducing sediment and litter pollution with joint innovative monitoring and control tools and nature-based practices**" and acronym "**Protect-Streams -4-Sea**", BSB963.
